Creating Public Myth: The 9/11 Commission Report

Tuesday, July 10, at 7 pm in Portsmouth

Dr. Thomas Hansen, researcher, author, and teacher, will speak in Portsmouth about some of the unanswered questions of the events of 9/11. In his research, Philip Zelikow, the Executive Director of the 9/11 Commission, told Dr. Hansen that he and his staff made a conscious decision not to dignify "outrageous conspiracy theories" about 9/11 by investigating them or reporting on them. In published academic articles, Dr. Zelikow describes his own area of academic expertise as "creating public myth". Along with the presentation and discussion, Dr. Hansen will be singing several original songs about 9/11. According to Dr. Hansen, "It is time to get beyond simply labeling people as 'conspiracy theorists', and instead to tell the truth about 9/11."
